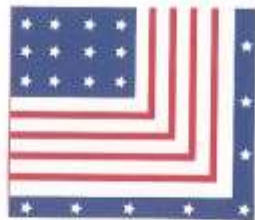

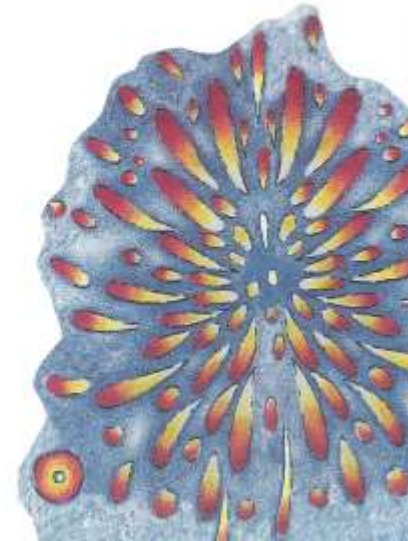

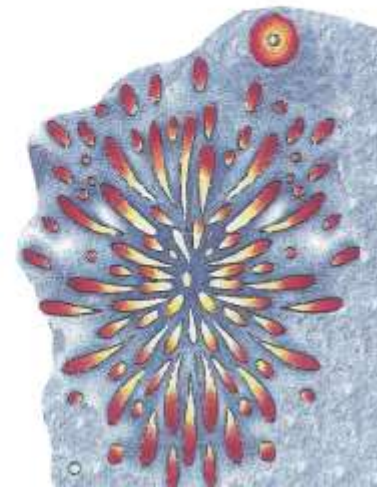

# Volunteer use expands

## Reimbursement test is credited

WASHINGTON — At Pearl Harbor Naval Station, Hawaii, volunteers are working at the brig. In other areas they're working in chapels, libraries, youth-service and medical facilities — and unlike before, are getting reimbursed for expenses.

The ranks of volunteers have swelled within the last several months as the Defense Department tests a pilot program aimed at expanding the use of volunteers on bases.

In the past, reimbursement for volunteers' expenses such as mileage and child care have been limited to a small number of family programs, museums and some organizations that deal with natural resources.

### More expenses are paid

The 50 installations in the pilot program are allowed to expand it to other areas on base, such as medical facilities, libraries and gymnasiums.

Volunteers at these organizations are now paid expenses for using their cars and putting their children in child-care centers. Also, they receive training and have liability coverage for injuries.

Air Force family officials declined to comment on their pilot program, said Maj. Bob Watson, a spokesman.

But the other services weren't as reticent.

Early word from the field is that the program, whose results will be known in the fall, is a success.

"Volunteers save the Marine Corps hundreds of thousands of dollars a

year, maybe more, just by the services they provide," said Maj. Brian Murray, family service center program manager for the Marine Corps. "They come in, ask what needs to be done, and do it, without asking to be paid."

"The new law has opened up many doors," he said, referring to the provision in last year's Defense Authorization Act that broadened the reimbursement program. That legislation also required the pilot program.

But money is still a worry. Officials are evaluating how much the expanded program would cost. Except for the two Marine Corps installations, all the bases are paying their own costs. Each Marine base was given \$3,000 for the five-month test.

Army bases are using more morale, welfare and recreation funds than taxpayer dollars, according to an interim report by Jennie Nash, manager of the Army's family member employment assistance program.

The legislation allows, but does not require, that volunteers be reimbursed for expenses. It does, however, require the services to pay their workers' compensation for injuries. Volunteers can also file claims for damages or loss.

Another concern, said Navy Cmdr. Leslie Page, is that installations might need to create a billet for someone to oversee the program. Page is head of the transition, relocation and deployment support branch for the Navy.
